

How to stream from your computer



Easy read fact sheet

This fact sheet will tell you how to:



1. Make a Twitch account.



2. Download Twitch Studio.



3. Start playing your game.



4. Start streaming.



Streaming is where people can watch you play a game online.



You can raise money for SeeAbility by streaming a game.

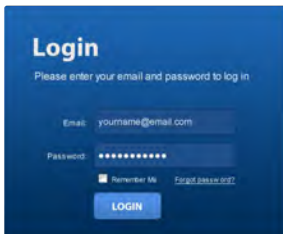


This guide is for streaming on a computer.

1. Make a Twitch account

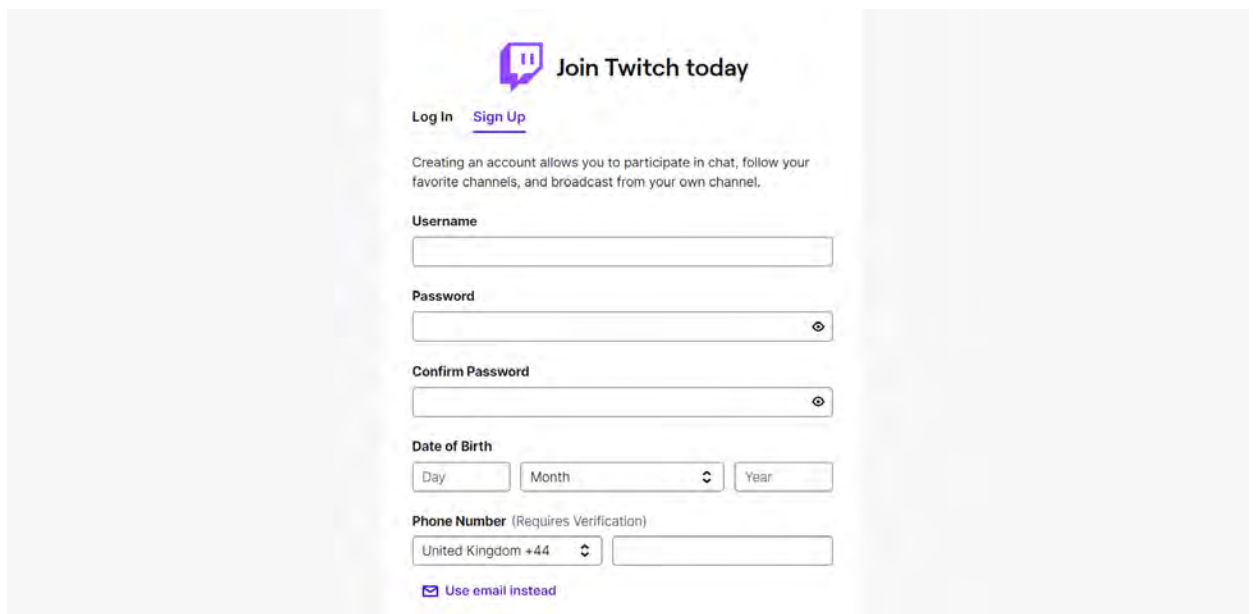


You will need to make a Twitch account so you can stream.



You make a Twitch account at this website link:

www.twitch.tv/signup



Username

This is the name people will know you by on Twitch. You can always change it later.

Type in a username.

This will be the name people see on Twitch.

Password

Type in a password.

You will need to remember this password.

Confirm Password

Confirm your password by typing it in again.

Date of Birth

Put in your date of birth.

Phone Number (Requires Verification)

Type in a mobile phone number.

It needs to be a phone you have near you.

Sign Up

Click the 'sign up' button.



Twitch will send a text message to your phone with a number in.

Verify phone number

Enter your verification code

We sent a 6-digit code to +44 7496 188090.
Confirm it belongs to you to keep your account secure.

Twitch may use your phone number to call or send text messages with information regarding your account.

Type in the number sent to you in the text from Twitch.

Make sure you keep your username and password safe.

2. Download Twitch Studio



You need to download a program called Twitch Studio on to your computer.

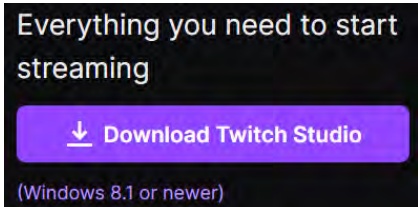


You download Twitch Studio at this website link:

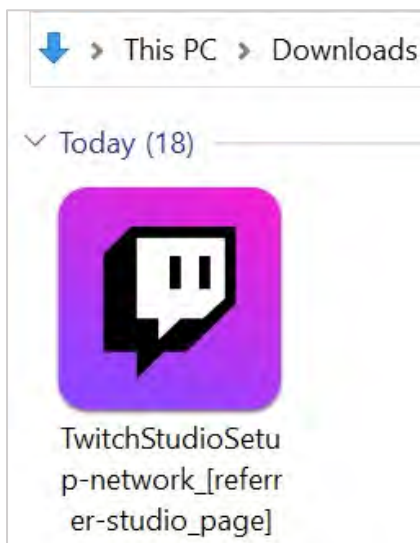
If you are not using your own computer make sure you ask permission to download Twitch Studio.



Click the button that says 'Download Twitch Studio'.



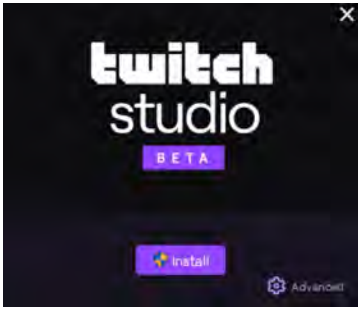
This will download a program on to your computer.



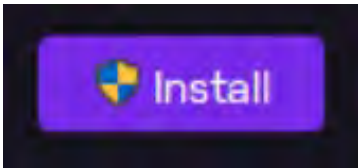
Open the 'downloads' folder on your computer to find the program.

It may pop up automatically.

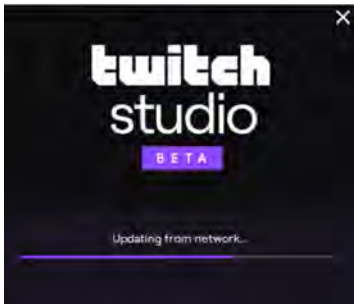
Open the program called 'Twitch Studio Set Up'.



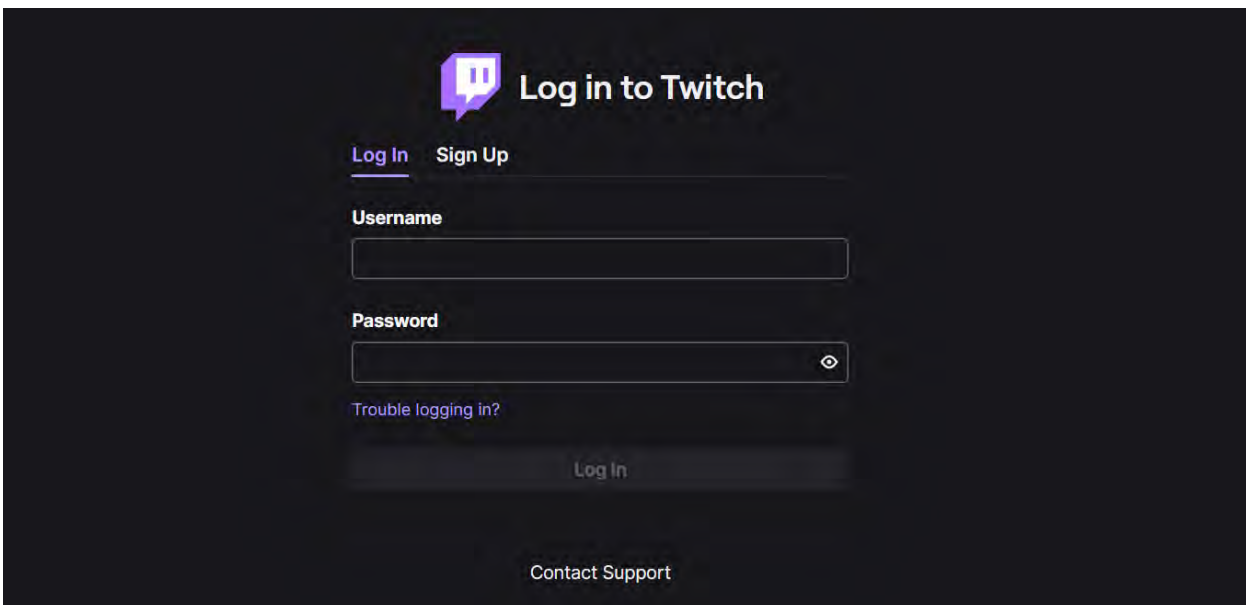
This will open up a black box with Twitch Studio on it.



Click the 'Install' button.



Twitch Studio will open when it has downloaded.



Username

Put in the username you chose earlier.

Password

Put in your password.

Log In

Click log in.



It might send you another text message with a number in.

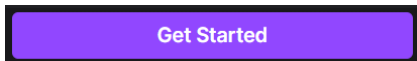
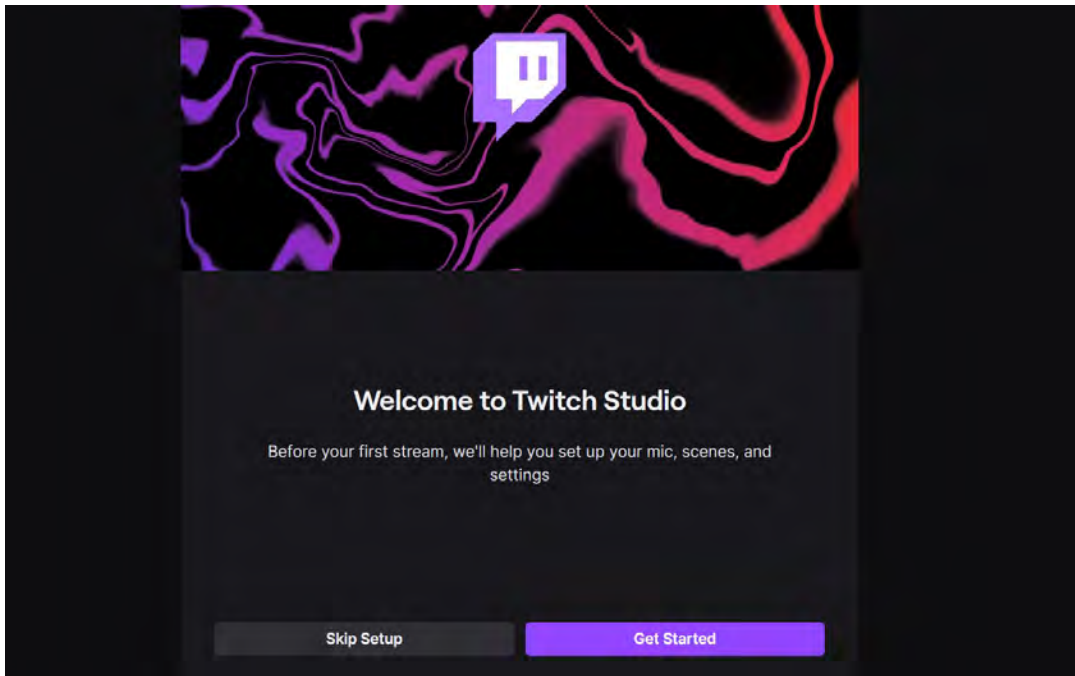

Enter that number in and press submit.



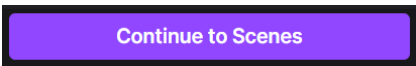
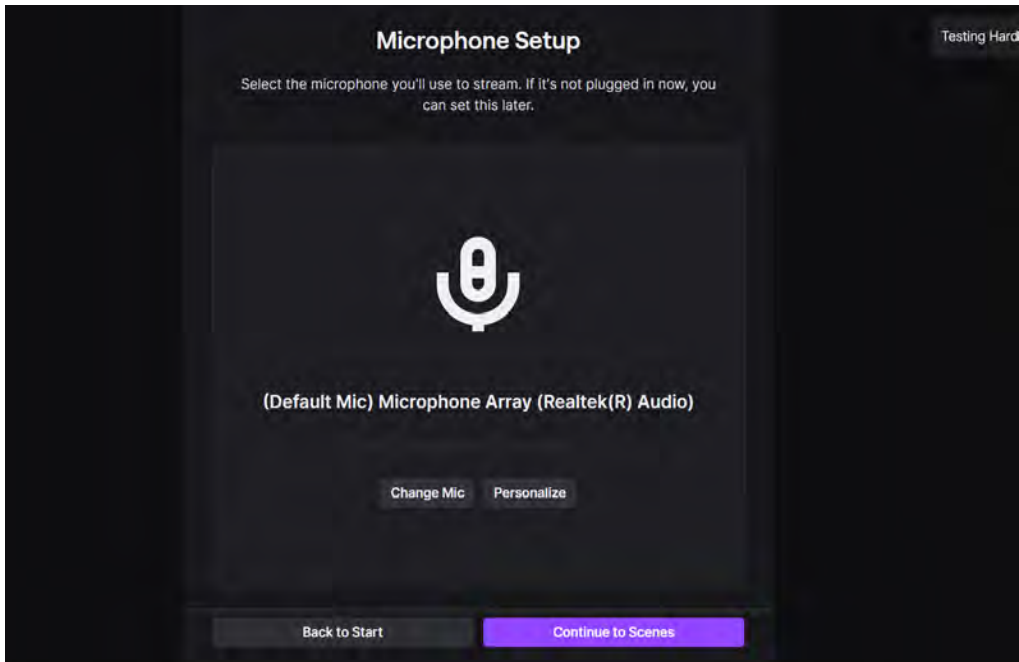
Press the button that says 'Get Started'.



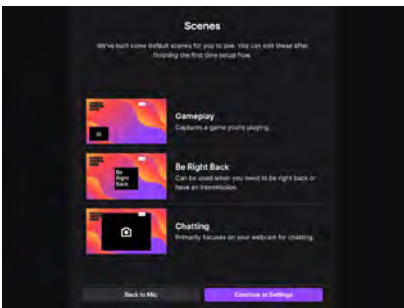
Twitch will now check if your microphone is working.



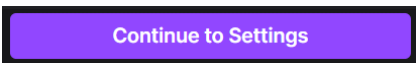
A microphone will let you talk to other people but you don't have to use it.



Click the button that says 'Continue to Scenes'.



You don't need to do anything with this screen yet.



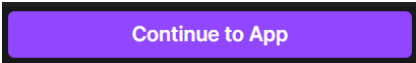
Click the button that says 'Continue to Settings'.



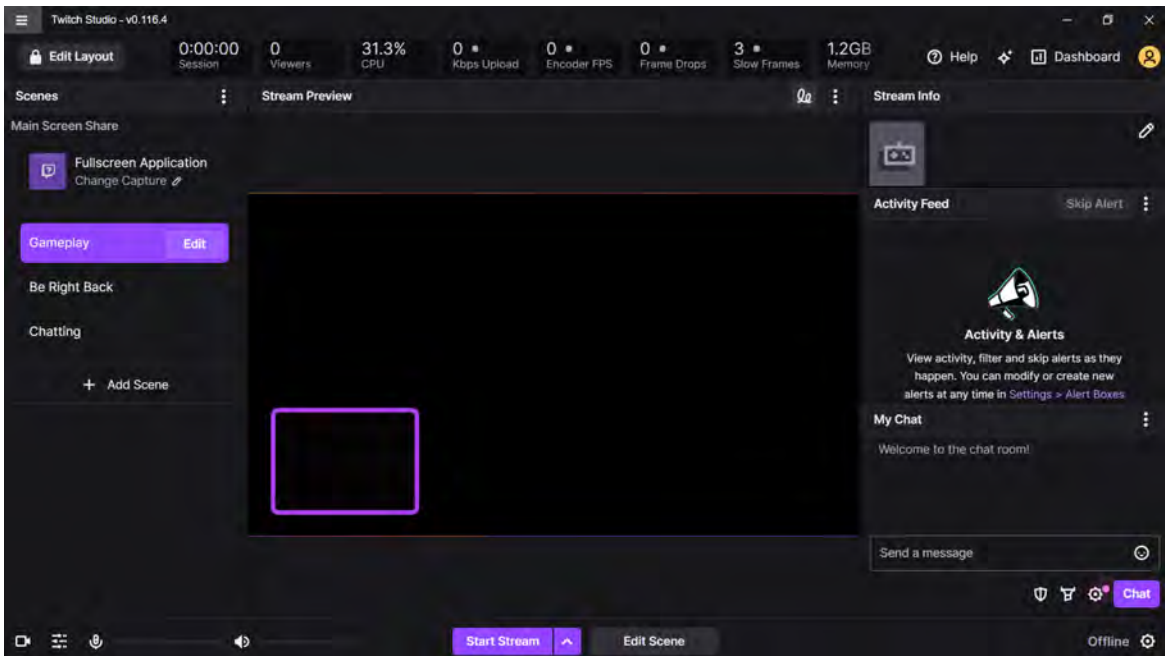
The next page checks that your internet is strong enough to stream.

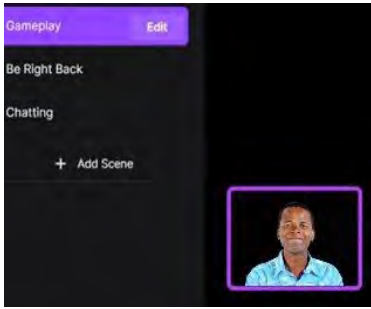


If your internet isn't strong enough, you won't be able to stream.

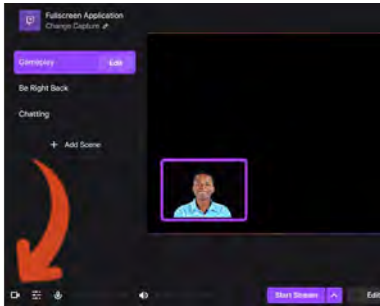


Click the button that says 'Continue to App'.





If your computer has a camera your face might be on the screen.



If you don't want people to see your face you can turn off the camera.



Press the camera button in the bottom left-hand side of the screen.



If you don't want people to hear you, press the microphone button.



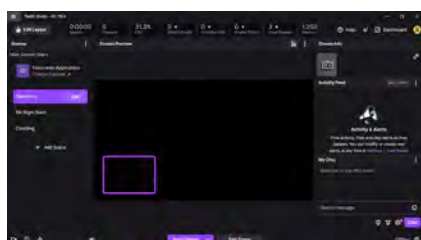
The microphone button is next to the camera button.

Playing the game

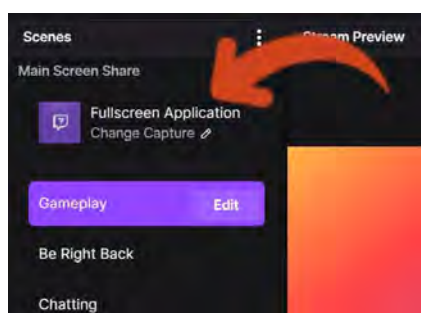


Open a game on your computer.

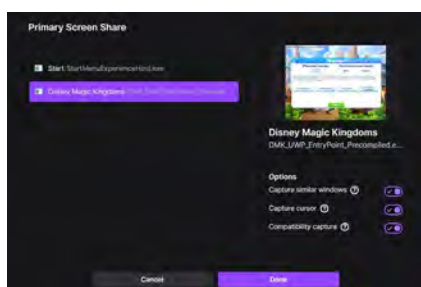
This will be different on different computers.



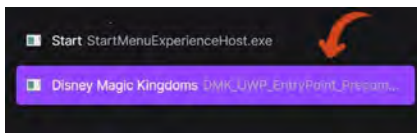
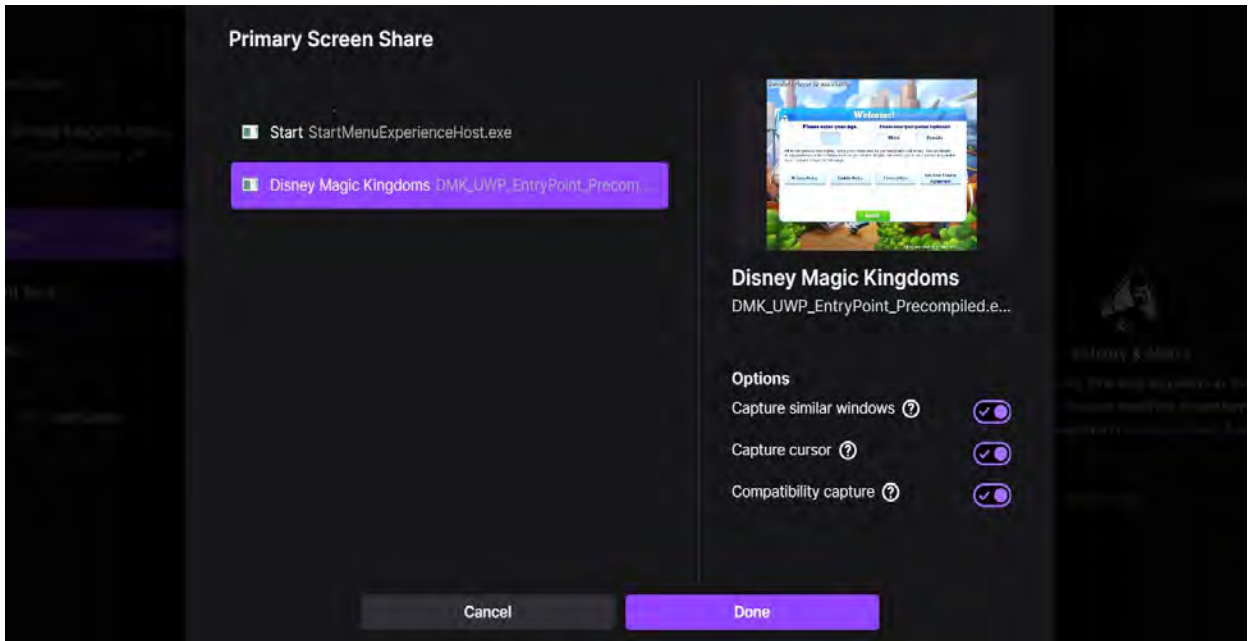
Go back to the Twitch Studio program.



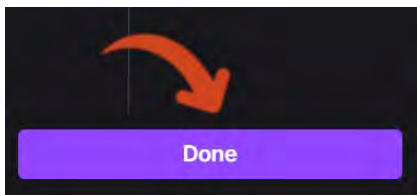
Click on the button that says 'Change Capture'.



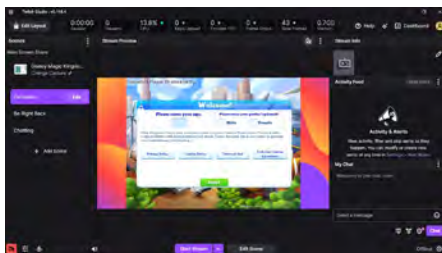
A new screen will appear that says 'Primary Screen Share'.



Click on the game you want to play.



Click the button that says 'Done'.



Your game will now show on the screen.

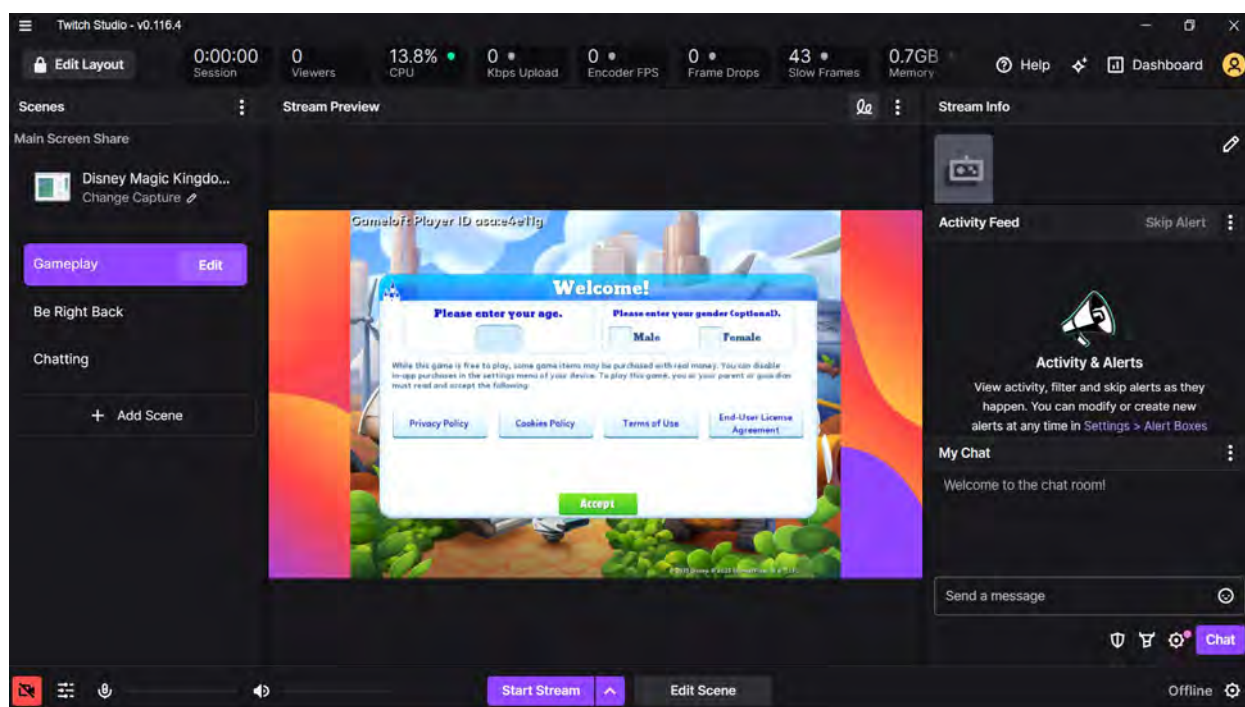
4. Start streaming



When you start streaming, people will be able to watch you playing your game.

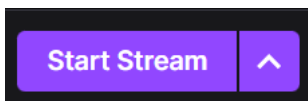


They will also see your face and hear your voice unless you turned it off.





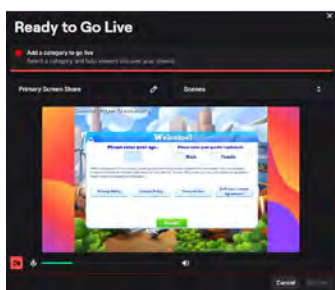
Make sure you are ready before you start to stream.



Click the button that says 'Start Stream' at the bottom of the screen.

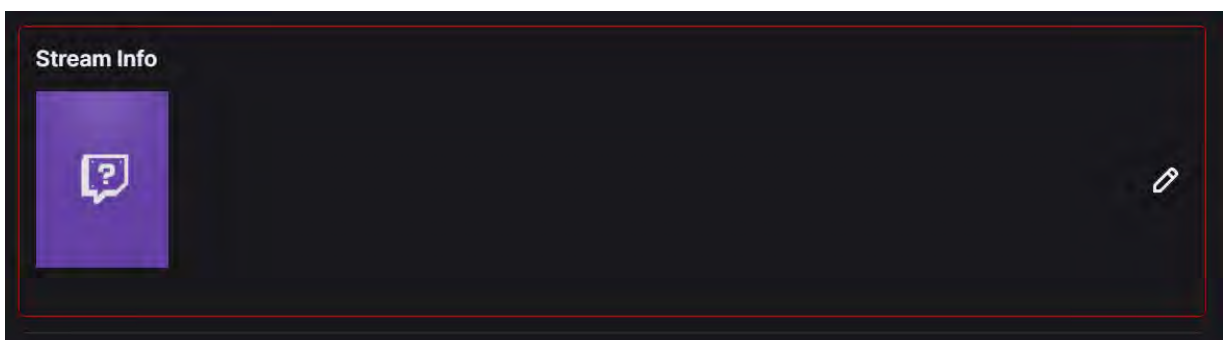


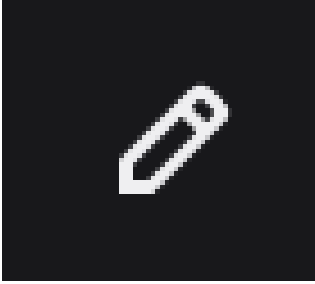
A new page will open that says 'Ready to Go Live'.



Go to the section called 'Stream Info'.

You might need to scroll down.

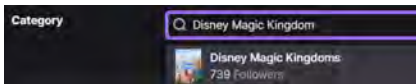




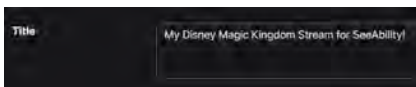
Click the edit button that looks like a pencil.



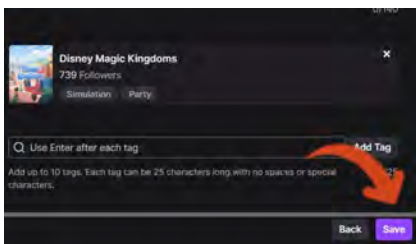
Go to the text that says 'Category'



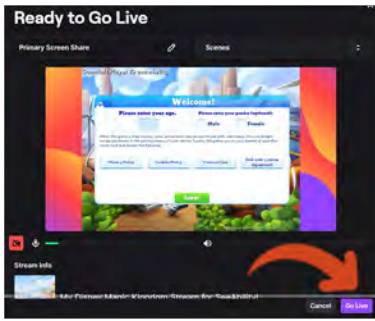
Enter the name of the name you are playing into the search box and click on it.



You can enter a name for your stream in the 'Title' box.



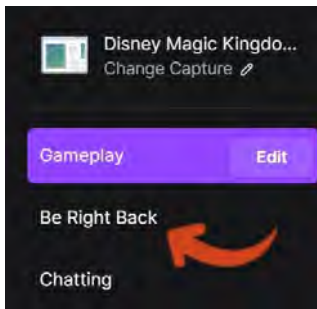
Press the save button.



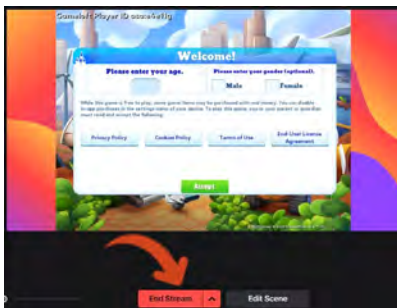
Click the button that says 'Go Live' when you want to start streaming.



You will now be streaming and people can watch you play your game.



If you want a break you can click the button that says 'Be Right Back'.



If you want to end the stream you click the button that says 'End Stream'.
